

### **Healthcare for refugees from Ukraine: updated to 13th May 2022**

- If you do not have a Green Certificate (digital document with QR code) you must take a nasopharyngeal swab test for SARS-CoV-2.
- If you do not have an accommodation at your relatives' or acquaintances' house and you must access to a shelter/emergency centre (struttura di accoglienza), you must take a nasopharyngeal swab test for SARS-CoV-2.
- Healthcare is guaranteed **for free**. To get free healthcare you must have the **Regional health service card**:
  - if you **applied for a residence permit** at the central Police Station (Questura) for temporary or international protection and you obtained the **receipt of your application and the fiscal code** (codice fiscale), you can have a temporary health card. Minors and pregnant women can have the health card immediately. With such health card you can go for free to any family doctor or pediatrician, for visits and prescription of medicines or diagnostic checks;
  - when you **obtain the residence permit** from the Police Station, **you must go to "Uffici scelta/revoca" of ASST to choose a family doctor or pediatrician;**
  - if you still do not have the health card but you need healthcare **that cannot be postponed**, you can directly access to health care centres **as an absolute exception**.
- Both children and adults **must receive the vaccination against SARS-CoV-2, also to get the Green Pass**, and it is important to verify if they comply with all vaccination requirements.
- Nursery school (children 0-6 years): they must comply with vaccination requirements and must show the vaccination certificate.
- Primary and secondary school (minors 6-18 years): they can start to attend school, but they must show the vaccination certificate as soon as possible.
- If you have a pet with you, you must fill in the "pet registration form" and send it to ATS to have access to the free service of identification/registration and health check for your pet.
- FFP2 masks must be worn on all means of transport, in all health care centres and social care centres (until 31st May).
- In case of fever and/or respiratory symptoms, take immediately a nasopharyngeal swab test for SARS-CoV-2, free of charge and without reservation, and contact a doctor.
- Only for sanitary **emergency/urgency**, call the emergency number 112 or go to an emergency department.
- Women who are **pregnant** or have **obstetrical/gynaecological problems** can access for free to medical assistance at the **family counselling** of ASST.

To obtain the health card and to choose a family doctor or pediatrician, go to "Uffici scelta/revoca" of ASST.

To receive vaccination against SARS-CoV-2, go to the CoViD Vaccination Centres of ASST.

To receive other vaccinations, go to the Vaccination Centres of ASST.

To take nasopharyngeal swab test for SARS-CoV-2, go to the drive-through testing site of ASST (Centri tamponi).
